SALT & ICE MELT DISSOLVER

DESCRIPTION:

SALT NEUTRALIZER is a concentrated ice melt dissolver that rapidly removes salt residue when used in warm water. SALT NEUTRALIZER is biodegradable and contains no phosphorus, glycol ethers, chlorine or solvents.

USES:

For use on all floor surfaces to remove winter weather related residue using a wet mop, auto scrubber or carpet extractor where ice melt has been tracked in. SALT NEUTRALIZER will not harm floor finish.

LIQUID PROPERTIES:

COLOR.....	Very Light Straw

FLAMMABILITY.....	Non-Flammable
SHELF LIFE.....	1 Year 22°C 30 Days 50°C
STABILITY.....	Freeze-Thaw Stable
ODOR.....	None

DIRECTIONS:

1. Sweep area being cleaned to remove loose debris.
2. Put wet floor signs out where appropriate.
3. Mop or auto scrub area.
4. Let air dry.
5. Take wet floor signs back to their storage area

DILUTIONS:

Mop buckets

Dilute 2 ounces of SALT NEUTRALIZER per 4 gallons of warm water.

Auto Scrubber

Dilute 2 ounces of SALT NEUTRALIZER per 8 gallons of warm water.

Carpet extractor

Dilute 2 ounces of SALT NEUTRALIZER per 8 gallons of warm water.

CAUTIONS:

Highly concentrated. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Gloves and eye protection are recommended. DO NOT use in concentrated form. Always dilute with water before application

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

EMERGENCY ACTIONS:

For external skin contact, flush with water. If eye is contacted, flush with water and seek medical assistance if irritation continues. If ingested, induce vomiting. Give large amounts of water and seek medical attention at once!
