CONCENTRATED GREASE, OIL, & ANIMAL FAT DEGREASER AND CLEANER

DESCRIPTION:

DEGREASE is a highly concentrated blend of surfactants, emulsifiers, and builders, that aggressively cleans and degreases in one operation. While very effective on normal greases and oils, DEGREASE also has been proven to be particularly effective in degreasing animal fats. Its high foaming action provides extra cling to vertical surfaces for more effective cleaning.

USES:

For emulsifying oils, greases and animal fats and the cleaning of hard surfaces.

DILUTIONS:

For VERY HEAVY DEGREASING - Dilute 1 part DEGREASE to 32 parts water. (4 oz/gal)

For HEAVY DEGREASING - Dilute 1 part DEGREASE to 64 parts water. (2 oz/gal)

For MEDIUM DEGREASING - Dilute 1 part DEGREASE to 128 parts water. (1oz/gal)

For LIGHT CLEANING - Dilute 1 part DEGREASE to 192 parts water. (3/4 oz/gal)

For maintaining, cleaning and degreasing quarry tile floors, dilute to 1/2 to 1oz per gal of water

SHELF LIFE.....	1 Year 22°C 30 Days 50°C

ODOR.....	Mild Neutral

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 Apply diluted solution liberally to surface. DO NOT treat more than 250 sq ft at one time
- 2 Allow solution to remain on floor for 2-5 minutes before scrubbing
- 3 Remove solution with vacuum or mop.
- 4 Rinse thoroughly with cold water.

CAUTIONS:

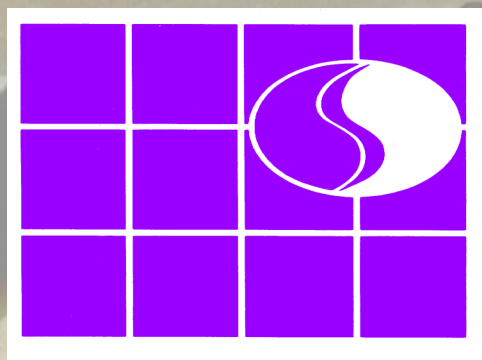
